Congratulations boys for an exciting season.

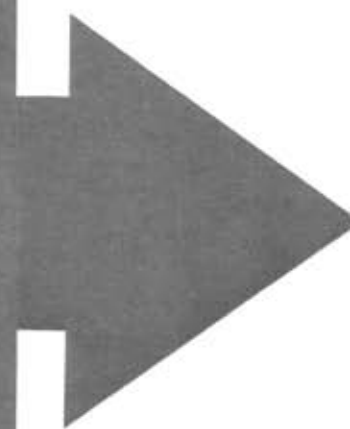
